

### THE SCM ARE COMING TO FBC SKIATOOK

On February 4th our sanctuary will reverberate to the sound of 130 singers and 35 musicians as they proclaim the glory of God in music. The Singing Churchmen of Oklahoma have performed their music for over 50 years across Oklahoma, the US and in Spain, China, Russia, Israel, Australia, Armenia, and Latvia. They have several recordings to their credit and recently completed their second partner project with Lifeway, featuring the Singing Churchwomen and Churchmen together.

This will be a major outreach event to our community that will require an army of volunteers. If you would be willing to help us host this event, please let Bro. Scott know. We will need the following teams of volunteers:

### USHERS / GREETERS

With 160+ people arriving throughout the day we will need a troop of greeters, pointers and van drivers to get the SCM to the right places. Plus we will need a team that night to welcome concert goers, collect the offering and handle crowd issues.

### HOSPITALITY

We will be feeding the 30 orchestra members a light lunch, and the entire group an afternoon snack and evening meal. Barbara Trego will be looking for people to help cook, serve and provide snack food.

### BUILDERS / SET UP

Probably the largest task will be outfitting our stage to accommodate the singers and orchestra. We had the small group (70-75) scheduled last year but got "iced out." This year we have the larger group coming, so we have to make some additional temporary modifications to our stage area to handle the group. We will be working the weekend and entire week before the concert to get this ready, so if you can give any evenings or days to this team it will be greatly appreciated.

### MISCELLANEOUS

And in addition to these teams, there are a variety of other odds and ends jobs that will need to be done in the days leading up to the concert (set up classrooms for dressing areas, poster distribution, mail outs, etc.)
