Our "year one" Journey of Faith pledge period begins this month and will run from June 1, 2013 - May 31, 2014. We will gladly accept additional pledges or unpledged gifts through out the year, but as of June 2 we have around **80** initial pledges totaling **\$180,000**. We anticipate that this amount, along with the reserve funds we have now and the usual year end giving we receive, should allow us to meet the first year goal of \$350,000. However, we will need to grow numerically and enlist more givers by the spring of 2014 to maintain this level in year two. The Stewardship Team will monitor the pledge receipts for the next 90 days to determine the rate of receipts and will then bring a recommendation to the church on when to make a lump sum payment from reserves and how much that should be. *As always, we will keep you posted on JOF giving each week in the "Glance At Last Week" section of the bulletin and, starting this month, we will give you an end of month loan balance and total monthly payment on the last Sunday or more often if larger gifts / payments are made that need to be reported.*

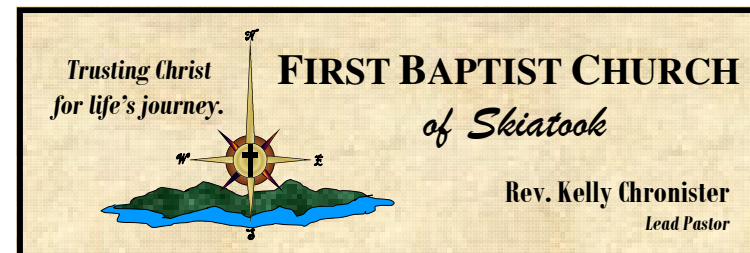
