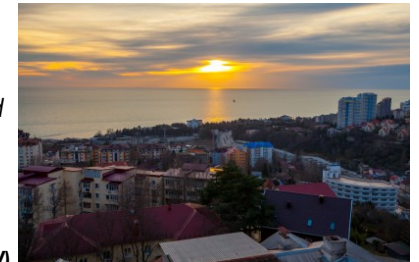
you can begin to pray about as supporting local believers is a major emphasis of the Engage Sochi mission.

- 1) We will contact the three major network stations (2,6,8) as soon as we make a decision regarding closure. If power outages are an issue, we will contact KRMG and KXOJ radio, too.
- 2) We will always attempt to open the church for Sunday morning services. If the weather is extremely bad, we may open for worship only, but we have people who can always make it and some who may need to make it because of outages at home.
- 3) Decisions concerning Sunday night services will be announced at the morning services.
- 4) If school is cancelled on Wednesday because of weather, we will also cancel the evening church activities.
- 5) **BOTTOM LINE!** *The best rule is your own common sense and personal comfort. If you do not feel safe getting out, then please don't. Better safe than sorry.*
