Harry Potter's wand...Aladdin's lamp...Gollum's "my precious"... items of supernatural power that we all would love to possess! But, alas, they're only fictional artifacts that will perform their mystical powers solely in our imaginations.

In Nehemiah 8, we read the account of Ezra bringing out the book of the law to read to the people. This was a practice that had been forgotten and neglected for years following the Babylonian captivity. But now that the new wall around Jerusalem was completed "by the hand of God," Nehemiah and Ezra commanded the people to gather to gratefully acknowledge God.

In that gathering, they were deeply convicted by the words of God's law and challenged by the long-forgotten commandments He had given to Moses. The people determined they must immediately begin preparations to observe "all that God had commanded them." You see, the people of Israel were transformed by a shared belief that the Book of the Law of Moses was "the word of God" ...not Moses' words about God, but words spoken to Moses BY GOD! Centuries later Paul would concur...

And for this reason we also constantly thank God that when you received from us the word of God's message, you accepted it not as the word of men, but for what it really is, the word of God, which also performs its work in you who believe.

1 Thessalonians 2:13 (NASB77)

Are you getting this? Hiding on a dusty shelf at home... sitting beneath the pew under your purse...or waiting behind an icon on your iPhone is something more precious than Gollum's ring, more powerful than Aladdin's lamp and more transformational than Harry's wand. It's the Word of God! Invoked by the Father, inspired by His Spirit and incarnate in the life of His Son, it is the "living and active" Word of God that can mystically "discern the thought and intentions of the heart" (Heb. 4:12) and powerfully do whatever it wills and go wherever it desires.

So shall My word be which goes forth from My mouth; It shall not return to Me empty, without accomplishing what I desire, and without succeeding in the matter for which I sent it.

Isaiah 55:11 (NASB77)

Not unlike so many of the "magical legends" of fiction, the Word of God is a tool that must be handled with care and honest intentions (2 Timothy 2:15). But when we understand it, apply it and obey it, the transformative power of God's Word is life-giving, lifechanging and life-preserving. Kind of magical, huh?


A another offering will be collected at the Community Worship Service in the Park for a local Pastor entering the mission field
