GREAT LEGACIES

In 2007 we dedicated the new Falls Creek tabernacle which replaced a 75 year-old open-air tabernacle. When we began the design phase, I was a little shocked at the square foot prices being tossed around. When I questioned, "Why so much higher than conventional construction?" the answer was simple, "This isn't conventional construction." Size and location were big factors, but probably the biggest was quality. Quite simply put, we wanted this building to last as long or longer than the one it was replacing and now days, unless you're building a skyscraper, most contemporary construction is modular and designed to be replaced or significantly repurposed in a matter of 20-30 years. It's a testament to the fact that we expect everything to change sooner than later... nothing lasts forever.

But there are those things that, though they may evolve or perhaps even fade away, the impact they have on us is lifechanging. Sunday we heard several of our Super Summer youth allude to this as they were tossing around the word "legacy." As one of our youth reminded us, legacies can be positive or negative, but either way they leave a lifelong mark. I remember when I was 7 years old I became a lifelong New York Yankees fan because their line-up was the epitome of baseball legacy. Mantle, Maris, Tresh, Kubek, Berra, Howard, Boyer, Pepitone, Richardson, Downing, Bouton...these were synonymous with Yankee pride ...no jumping ship for a few more dollars. No, they played for the honor of the pinstripes and so I proudly wore Mickey's No. 7 jersey for all of little league.

Not many positive legacies are being constructed these days, so, let me quickly extol the virtues of a century old legacy worthy of our support and participation...the aforementioned Falls Creek. From 1917-1951 they held one 2-week session which expanded to three 2-week sessions by 1957. The need to accommodate more churches led them to go to multiple one week sessions and eventually expand to eight sessions in 2007, plus 2 kids camps, Cross-Timbers Camp and a nation-wide Native American camp. Since its founding in 1917 through its centennial in 2017, the regular session attendance grew from 1,000 per summer to over 50,000 each summer. Over 2.7 million teenagers have attended Falls Creek with 10+% of those making a life-changing decision for Christ. In the last two decades we have seen 2,000+ professions of faith almost every summer. More Oklahoma pastors and SBC missionaries have received their calling at Falls Creek than anywhere else on earth.

I close with these two quotes from men who would know the legacy of Southern Baptists...

"For many years, I have wondered why Oklahoma Baptists have provided so many of our denominational workers and missionaries. I think in Falls Creek I have found the secret."


