

ABOUT

Mekong Reunion is an annual conference that runs for 6 days, providing fellowship, Bible teaching and prayer for Christian workers in five countries across South East Asia. Whilst adults are being spiritually and physically renewed, an international team of more than 15 will offer a similar experience for the children of these Christian workers.

Mekong Reunion will have 85 adults and about 75 children attending, ranging in age from babies to teens. The children of these Christian workers are known as TCKs.

WHO ARE TCKs?

TCKs are Third Culture Kids who spend a number of their growing years in a culture other than their parents' passport culture. Typically they are well equipped to handle cross-cultural situations as they grow in an environment enriched by many languages.

However, frequent moving means they find it hard to identify with a geographical location they can call home. Mobility shortens relationships and friendships nurtured through being together at Reunion are very important.

Age 0 – 2s	Childcare during morning and afternoon programs.
Age 3 – 12s	Similar to a daily vacation Bible school or holiday club. Includes Bibles stories, singing, games, crafts and outdoor activities such as swimming. Morning, afternoon and some evenings.
Teenagers	Similar to a youth group. Includes mornings, afternoons and some evenings.
